Medium: **Size 8"x10" to 18"x24", in Watercolor, Oil Paint, Acrylic, Ink, Pencil, Crayon, Marker, and Pastel**
No digital or framed art work

Deadline: **Monday, November 16th, 2015**

Participants must be students in grades K-12 or in College living within the jurisdiction of the Consulate General of Japan in Atlanta (Alabama, Georgia, North Carolina, and South Carolina).
Winners will be announced in early 2016.

All entries must have a completed artwork release form affixed to the back of the artwork. Use a clear glue stick or tape to attach the form. Do not staple or paper clip the form as it damages the artwork.
