1. 誘拐・強姦事件（モービル地区）

見出し： "Mobile woman kidnapped and raped by man she met on social media"

要旨： Officers responded to a call at the 1400 block of Stone Hedge Drive. At the scene, a female victim said she had been taken against her will. The victim was using the Whisper app when she arranged a meeting with a user she thought was a woman, police say. She invited the woman to her home. When she approached a vehicle that arrived at her residence however, police say an unknown man held her at gunpoint and demanded she get inside the vehicle. According to police officials, the assailant drove the victim to an abandoned home and sexually assaulted her.

An official said that the shooting did not appear to be a random act and authorities are treating it as a double homicide. Authorities also said that it appears there were multiple shooters.

^{ようし}要旨 : Deputies were looking for a 47-year-old man at a home located in the 8800 block of Emerald Lake Drive West at 5 p.m. on Tuesday. Deputies were allowed inside residence, but man they were searching for was not located. Self Deputies found meth and drug paraphernalia during the search. The department's Narcotic Unit was called and agents were sent to the scene with a search warrant for the residence. During a second search, agents found six ounces of meth, prescription pills, marijuana, two slot machines, body armor and 11 guns. The meth has an estimated street value of \$16,800.

要旨： The Tuscaloosa Police Department's Juvenile Division received information about a man possession obscene material. Lawmen carried out a search warrant at the man's apartment. The search turned up multiple images on the man's phone including naked, pre-pubescent girls engaged in deviate sexual acts with adult men. In one of the images, a teddy bear was also captured in the photo. Police on Wednesday charged the suspect with four counts of unlawful possession of obscene matter containing the visual depiction of persons under the age of 17 involved in obscene acts.

要旨 : The 44-year-old man told investigators a white Lexus with Florida tags pulled next to him in the 5800 block of Cedar Croft Lane near Lithonia. Two teens jumped out of the vehicle and attempted to rob the man at gunpoint, DeKalb police said Thursday. That, police said, is when the man pulled out his own gun, shot one of teens and called 911. Officers responded about 10:30 p.m. and found the teen in the road with a gunshot wound. He was taken to Grady Memorial Hospital, where he later died. And six members of the Iron Cross Motorcycle Club in Coweta County face criminal charges after authorities connected them with gang activity, according to authorities. When they arrived, police found a man with a single stab wound to his chest. He was taken to a local hospital, where he later died from his injuries. Officers learned that the victim got into an argument with a man that police said the victim knew prior to the argument. The argument escalated into a physical altercation resulting in the victim being stabbed, police said. According to police, the man was pronounced dead shortly after arriving at the hospital. 要旨^{ようし} : Arrest warrants accuse a 51-year-old Raleigh man of raping a young girl after kidnapping her on a Wake County road on Labor Day. The suspect was arrested Wednesday afternoon by Wake County sheriff's investigators at Sedgewood Drive and Knickerbocker Parkway in northwest Raleigh and held in lieu of \$1 million bail. The arrest warrants charge the suspect with first-degree kidnapping, two counts of statutory rape of a child under 15 years old and taking indecent liberties with a child.

要旨^{ようし} : Police found a 5-year-old girl burned, bruised and extremely malnourished, but alive locked in a closet in an empty home in Randolph County. There were no cars in the driveway and no one else was at the home where police found the girl Tuesday in the 200 block of Back Street, according to WXII News. The girl had no food or water when police found her locked inside a 2-by-4-foot closet under a stairway, the station reported. Police reportedly responded to a tip that the girl was being mentally and physically abused. After no response to knocking on the door, police called the girl's name and began to

hear her, WXII reported. Responding to police calls from outside the home, the girl indicated she was not OK and that she needed help, according to WFMY News. Police at that point broke into the home through a window. The girl was transported to a local children's hospital. Both the girl's father and caretaker now face felony charges of child abuse.
