要旨: An investigation is underway after a man was shot to death Saturday morning in Bessemer. Bessemer police and fire medics responded at 10:50 a.m. to 28th Street and 11th Avenue, according to police Chief Mike Roper. When they arrived on the scene, they found a 25-year-old man wounded by gunfire. Police have not yet established a motive or identified any suspects.

^{ようし}要旨 : It's been nearly five days since 3-year-old Kamille "Cupcake" McKinney was abducted while at a birthday party in Birmingham. The abduction happened about 8:30 p.m. Saturday at Tom Brown Village public housing community off of Messer-Airport Highway. Prayer vigil for Kamille "Cupcake" McKinney, the 3-year-old girl who was abducted from a birthday party Saturday night in Birmingham. Kamille was with her mother, April Thomas, and other family members at the birthday party in a parking lot off 41st Place North. Children attending the party said a black male got out of an SUV and put Kamille in the vehicle. Birmingham police investigators have said from the start that they do not believe the abduction was the result of a custodial issue. Shortly before midnight Saturday – about 3 ½ hours after the abduction – the Alabama Law Enforcement Agency issued an Amber Alert in Kamille's abduction. Also Saturday night, the Birmingham Police Department established a command post a couple of blocks away from the abduction site. Multiple agencies are assisting in the search, including the FBI, the U.S. Marshals Service, the Alabama Law Enforcement Agency, the Jefferson County Emergency Management Agency, the National Center for Missing and Exploited Children, the Jefferson County Sheriff's Office and the Shelby County Sheriff's Office. About 8 p.m. Sunday, residents at a Center Point condominium complex called 911 after finding the Toyota Sequoia parked outside. A resident and his girlfriend were taken into custody as persons of interest. The male who is detained was the man captured on store surveillance video. On Monday, Birmingham Police Chief Patrick Smith and Mayor Randall Woodfin held a press conference. Smith said the two detained are undergoing questioning. He also said investigators believe more people are in the kidnapping. 要旨 : The Mobile Police Department made its first arrest under a new law that increases the penalty for possession a stolen gun in Alabama. The arrest was made on Dauphin Island Parkway on Tuesday, October 8, at approximately 7:46 p.m., police say. Police pulled over Damontray Mack, 20, after observing he was driving with only one functioning headlight. After searching the vehicle, police say they were able to locate a silver Smith and Wesson firearm under the passenger seat and an AR pistol behind the driver seat. The Smith and Wesson firearm that was found under the passenger seat was reported stolen, police said. The AR pistol had no serial number.

He is charged in the Sunday-night slaying of 21-year-old Benjamin Elio Gonzalez. Deputies were dispatched just before 7 p.m. Sunday to the 1800 block of Martinique Drive N.E., said Deputy Chief David Agee. Neighbors called 911 after hearing shots fired in the area. When deputies got on the scene, they found Gonzalez unresponsive. He was pronounced dead on the scene. Jail records show Steele was booked into the lockup Monday night. He is being held without bond.

^{ようし}要旨 : Two men are in custody after what police describe as a major drug trafficking bust on Interstate 22 in Brookside. Brookside police on Friday announced the arrests of two men. The arrests are among several significant narcotics arrests made along I-22 multiple law enforcement agencies in the past several weeks, said Brookside Police. Brookside's Narcotics Interdiction officers on Thursday stopped a vehicle about 12:30 p.m. on I-22. Officers found a large amount of crystal meth on the vehicle's dash, seats, floorboard, as well as on the two suspects. Additionally, officers also found a gun stolen out of Homewood, used syringes, digital scales, more than 200 baggies used for drug sales and distribution, lock-picking tools, electronics, meth pipes and straws, handcuffs, several pieces of jewelry, raw diamonds, and other items still under investigation as potentially connected to area burglaries. The officers also found numerous concealed and hidden compartments throughout the vehicle suspected to be used to conceal and transport large amounts of narcotics. The pair is charged with trafficking crystal methamphetamine, receiving stolen property, possession of a controlled substance (ecstasy), possession of drug paraphernalia, felon in possession of firearm, possession of burglary tools, carrying a concealed weapon (brass knuckles), and unlawful possession of prescription medication. 要旨^{ようし}： A man accused of a crime spree in Florida, which includes a rape and a homicide, was arrested after an alleged carjacking and police chase in Atlanta over the weekend, authorities said. The suspect from Frostproof, Fla., was spotted in a Honda that had been carjacked in the 300 block of Edgewood Avenue at about 2:30 a.m. Saturday, Atlanta police said. Officers tried to pull the car over, but the vehicle's driver sped off before losing control and crashing. The suspect allegedly tried to run away before an officer used a Taser on him, ending the chase. A woman from Charlotte, N.C., was also in the vehicle and was arrested, police said. She was charged with four felonies, including aggravated assault, armed robbery and first-degree hijacking of a motor vehicle, Fulton County jail records show.

要旨^{ようし}： A jeweler was robbed of \$300,000 worth of jewelry at gunpoint in a downtown Atlanta high-rise condominium and hotel parking garage last week, authorities said. The 32-year-old victim spoke to said that he was rushed by an armed man after he parked his Mercedes-Benz sedan in the parking garage of Twelve Hotel at 400 West Peachtree Street last Wednesday. The man said the gunman pointed the weapon at his face and made him hand over two Rolexes and a Richard Mille watch among other items about 9 p.m., according to an Atlanta police incident report. His iPhone, a MacBook Pro, car keys and

要旨 : A former Bartow County firefighter is facing arson and weapons charges after officials said he stole 17 guns from a home while the owner was out of town and then set the house on fire. The suspect is charged with 16 felonies in connection with the incidents, jail records show. He was arrested Friday and fired Monday. According to Bartow County incident reports, the home on Old Mill Road was completely destroyed. The guns were not reported stolen until three days later. An arson investigation was opened after a witness, who knew the homeowner was away, told officials that he saw a blue Ford Expedition leaving the scene, according to one report. The homeowner later told deputies he believed the suspect broke into his home and stole 17 of his guns before setting it on fire. The flames spread to a nearby wooded area, resulting in a wildfire, authorities said. At least two firearms were pawned at a local shop the same day of the fire. 要旨 : A 16-year-old Pickens High School student was arrested Thursday morning after allegedly posting a photo online that appears to show two guns pointed at five students seated in a classroom. The guns weren't real, but the teenager used a Snapchat filter to superimpose the weapons over the picture of students, the Pickens County Sheriff's Office said. Written on the photo is a caption that says, "finna get my kd up," a reference to a video game player's kills-to-death ratio. The sheriff's office was made aware of the photo Thursday morning after the student posted it to his Instagram page the night before, authorities said. The student, who was not named because he is a juvenile, was arrested at school without incident and charged with one count of making terroristic threats.

要旨 : Investigators in Coweta County are trying to find a man they say hid inside a Costco until it closed and then stole nearly \$14,000 in jewelry. The incident happened at the store on Fischer Crossings

Boulevard, according to Channel 2 Action News. The wholesale retailer opened in that area in August. The Coweta sheriff's office said a man walked inside the store, cased the place and left. A few hours later, he came back. Investigators said the man waited there for nearly five hours until the store closed. He then emerged from his hiding spot and smashed a glass jewelry display case, according to surveillance video from the store. The man grabbed handfuls of jewelry and ran off, officials said. ^{ようし}要旨： Eleven men have been assaulted near bars in Wilmington, prompting police to warn those who go out drinking late at night. The men, including seven members of the military, were attacked in downtown Wilmington in Eastern North Carolina around the time bars closed for the night, the city's police department said Wednesday in a Facebook post. Police have now identified four victims who may have been sexually assaulted, officials say. The assaults are believed to stretch back to January 2018, with "sporadic" timing in between, according to Wilmington police. Officials discovered a link a few weeks ago, when the crimes started "escalating." The common thing about all 11 of these is a cognitive impairment where the victims don't remember anything. All they remember is being in a bar and that

they end up waking up the next day somewhere in the downtown area not remembering anything that happened. Police say that crime scene locations and other details are limited due to the condition of the victims at the time the incidents happened. Officers have joined state and federal agencies to investigate the series of attacks, some of which were initially reported as misdemeanors, according to Wilmington police. Officials have stepped up downtown patrols, the Facebook post says.

Deputies say the student made threats to other students on his school bus earlier this week, making "verbal threats to take the lives of others and inflict bodily harm upon another person," according to an arrest warrant. He allegedly told students he wanted to "shoot this bus up" on Tuesday, deputies say. Another student reported the comment to their parents, who contacted the Lexington County Sheriff's Department, according to a news release from Lexington District 4. The student was awaiting a bond hearing early Friday morning, deputies say. He was also suspended from school pending a district hearing, the school district said.
