1. 強盗未遂事件（バーミングハム市）

要旨： An off-duty officer was working an extra job when shots were fired about 4 a.m. Sunday at 528 Third Ave. West near The Palace Gentleman's Club. The officer found a man on the ground suffering from a gunshot wound, said Sgt. Rod Mauldin. The man was taken to UAB Hospital's Trauma Center where he was pronounced dead. Mauldin said the preliminary investigation shows the man was shot when he apparently approached someone to rob them. No other details were released.

Cullman police were able to take the man into custody after a spike belt slowed the patrol car down and another officer performed a pit maneuver to bring it to a stop. The man exited the cruiser and attempted to flee, but was taken into custody a short while later. Jay Jenkins said an armed black male wearing a hoodie pulled tight around his face enter the restaurant, went behind the counter and demanded cash drawers. An employee handed the suspect one of the drawers and was getting another when the gunman fired his weapon. Jenkins said the worker was struck in the leg and taken to an area hospital. The suspect fled the scene on foot. 要旨: Tuscaloosa authorities are investigating after a man was shot and killed Tuesday afternoon, and are holding a teenager on related charges. Police responded to 24th Street and Fosters Ferry Avenue on a shooting call around 3:30 p.m., according to the Tuscaloosa Violent Crimes Unit Capt. When officers arrived, they found a man dead in the roadway with an apparent gunshot wound. Investigators from the TVCU found a gun and multiple shell casings in the area. Officers arrested a 16-year-old for a weapons charge related to the incident. Investigators have identified several other people who were in the area at the time of yesterday's shooting and are working to find those people.

Once at the location, lawmen learned that shots had been fired but no one was struck by the bullets. A 15-year-old, however, was cut by broken glass. Witnesses report that the gunfire came from a vehicle as it drove by the home.

要旨： Two suspects face felony charges after being accused of robbing a T-Mobile store at gunpoint in Roswell before fleeing on Ga. 400. The incident began just after 4:50 p.m., when the two suspects robbed the T-Mobile store at 875 Mansell Road. It's unclear how many cellphones the duo is accused of stealing, but a photo released by police appears to show about two dozen phones were found in their vehicle. Roswell police were able to get a good description of the armed robbery suspects from the scene, providing it to other local law enforcement agencies. That allowed Sandy Springs police to assist Roswell officers in finding the fleeing suspects, who were driving south on the crowded freeway during the evening commute. Officers pulled over their vehicle and found the two suspects, the stolen cellphones and a firearm inside. 要旨 : Police are investigating two shootings at DeKalb County convenience stores that left two men dead Wednesday night. The first took place just after 6 p.m. at a Citgo gas station near the intersection of North Hairston Road and Central Avenue, DeKalb police said. The man, who was described as about 35 years old, was lying on the ground when officers arrived. He was shot in his upper torso. Investigators were looking for surveillance video that might help provide a good description of the suspect. The motive was unknown, but there was some indication that an altercation may have occurred before the shooting. Hours later, officers were called to another shooting at the Tic Toc food mart in Stonecrest. Police said the store owner was killed in the shooting. The man was found lying face down outside the store with a gunshot wound to his head. A series of gunshots heard just yards away from the officers' marked patrol car. Police found that a girl in her teens and a man in his early 20s had been shot. Their exact ages were not released. They were both taken to Grady Memorial Hospital with non-life-threatening injuries. The three men are accused of killing a 17-year-old on Wednesday. It was reported that the victim was shot near a shopping center at the corner of New Bern Avenue and Rogers Lane, then ran to nearby Duckling Way, where someone saw him collapse and called 911. He was taken to Wake Med where he died.

Emergency responders found one person had been shot, and other people were in the vehicle. The gunshot victim was taken to an area hospital and died, police said at about 10 p.m. Old Dutch Fork Road was closed for several hours as officers and agents from the South Carolina Law Enforcement Division searched for evidence and information on the gunfire. Police said the other people in the car at the time of the shooting have cooperated with investigators. No arrests were made and there were no searches for anyone else potentially involved in the shooting, according to the release.
